











Overview

Our outfitter in Slovakia offers well organized driven hunts in big parts of Slovakia. Our partner collaborates with some of Slovakia's best private hunting areas, and they do a great deal of work to always offer the visiting hunters the absolute best hunting areas, which are carefully selected.

The hunt

The Slovakian driven hunts is arranged for bigger groups of min. 20 hunters, and is known for varying game parades which normally consist of wild boars, red deer, fallow deer, mouflon and foxes, depending on the hunting area. Each hunting day consist of 2-4 longer drives, and all driven hunts takes place on free range areas, which normally range between 2.000 – 8.000 hectares of size. Depending on the size of the hunting area, each day will take place in a new area with fresh beaters and dogs.

The estimated number of animals shot within 3 days driven hunt, is around 50-100 pieces of game, depending on weather conditions and the hunters shooting skills. Last night our outfitter organizes a farewell party for the group, with wine tasting and traditional Slovakian food.

The journey

The trip begins with the group flying to either Budapest, Vienna or Bratislava. On arrival, our partner will meet and greet you in the airport, and transport the group by bus to the accommodation – approximately 1-2 hours' drive depending on which airport. Upon arrival to the

accommodation, a welcome dinner will await the hunters.

Accommodation

The accommodation takes place in a guesthouse or hotel which is recommended by our partner. During the stay, the group will have full board, with breakfast before the hunt at the guest house, lunch and dinner directly in the hunting area and after the hunt a late dinner at the guest house.

On the last day, the group will be transported back to the airport after breakfast and writing of hunting protocol.



Accommodation is provided in selected hotels or guest houses, depending on which districts you are hunting in. In some districts it is possible to stay in a hunting lodge belonging to the district itself.

Full board is provided during your stay. Breakfast will be served in the guesthouse before the hunt and lunch will be provided during the hunt. After hunting, hot soup is typically served once the parade is over. Back at the guest-house a late dinner will be served during the evening.

Hunters will typically sleep in two or three bedded rooms unless otherwise arranged. Your accommodation will have its own restaurant and bar, as well as a private lounge where the hunters can enjoy spending time in each other's company.



Our Slovakian driven hunts are generally arranged with private districts/hunting clubs, which range in size between 2,000 and 10,000 hectares. Depending on the size of the district's and game you wish to hunt for, you can change district from day to day, and there will be a suitable number of beaters and dogs at each individual district.

Normally 2 - 4 large drives will be carried out per day, during which the beaters move around the district, setting the game in motion. It is not unusual for each drive to last between 1,5 - 2 hours.

Depending on the district you are hunting in, hunt able species normally include wild boar, red deer, fallow deer, mouflon and fox (only non-trophy deer and mouflon)



Trophy pricelist

Shot game is settled according to the following pricelist and includes all wild boars and females and calves from red deer, fallow deer and maybe mouflon sheep/lambs. All shot game is shared by the group and each hunter must pay the same amount according to the number of game shot each day.

OBS: It is not allowed to shoot trophy game (red stag, fallow buck, and mouflon ram) on the Slovakian driven hunts.

For good order it should be mentioned that the driven hunts are not wild boar driven hunts, but a combination of the different game species such as wild boars, red deer, fallow deer and maybe mouflon. The districts expect that the hunters shoot at all kinds of game.

The Slovakian hunting areas are divided into different categories depending on the standard and game population. Our partner has access to more than 50 hunting grounds in the southwestern part of Slovakia, and these are categorized as "standard", "premium" and "premium plus". Normally we as a minimum offer "premium" areas, but you can choose to add 1-2 days in a "premium plus" area.

Usually a group of good shooters can expect the following results per hunting day:

Standard area - 10-25 pieces per day

Premium area - 20-24 pieces per day

Premium plus - 25-50 pieces per day

The hunt takes place in free range districts, and we cant give any guarantees for a certain number of game at the parade. Also the shooting skills in the group as well as the weather can have a big influence on the final result.


