

Travel to Slovakia and make your dreams of a big red stag come true! Experience the intense rutting season hunt for red stags in good, private districts with large populations of red deer and well organised hunting. You can expect a trophy in the 6-11 kg class.











Overview

Our new partner in Slovakia can offer some very attractive hunting for big red stags during the peak of the rutting season in September. Slovakia is home to some excellent populations of red deer, and you will hunt in beautiful, hilly areas where the red deer really thrive. Hunting will take place in the early morning and evening, with each outing lasting between 2 - 3 hours. Slovakia is renown for its big red stags and you can expect a stag in the 6-11kg trophy class. Here you have a good chance of bagging a really excellent trophy.

If hunt are hunting during the hight of the rutting season, it is possible to hunt throughout the day, as the stags are roaring around the clock. Once you have bagged your trophy it is possible to continue hunting for hinds and calves or for some of the other hunt able species. You can decide yourself if your trophy should be boiled and bleached, or wether it should be prepared for shoulder mounting. The outfitter will assist you with arranging transport of your trophies home.

Hunters will stay in a nearby hotel or guest house, in rooms with en suite facilities. The hotel offers a restaurant where you will have the possibility of trying some of the delicious local Slovakian food. The cost of a standard meal is between €5 - €10. Breakfast is included in the price. If you prefer more private surroundings, some of the districts can offer accommodation in a hunting lodge close to the hunting district, with the services of a private cook during your stay (at extra cost). Lodges are normally located in the forest, and are suitable for groups of between 4 to 10

You will be met at the airport by a driver who will transfer hunters to their accommodation by car or minibus, depending on the size of the group. Drive time will be between 1½ - 2½ hours.



Hunters will stay in a nearby hotel or guesthouse, in rooms with en-suite bathroom and toilet. There is a restaurant in the hotel where you can buy your meals. There is also a cosy bar. In some of the hotels we use there are also luxurious wellness facilities, which are at your disposal during your stay. If you would prepare more private surroundings, some of the districts can, on payment of a supplement offer accommodation in a hunting lodge close to the hunting district. Lodges are normally located in the forest, and are suitable for groups of between 4 to 12 hunters.

When staying at a hotel you must arrange your own meals during the day, giving you an excellent chance to sample some of the delicious local Slovakian dishes. The cost of a standard meal is between €5 - €10. Breakfast is included in the price.

If you choose to stay in a hunting lodge in the forest, there will typically be a private cook at your service during your stay. You should not expect gourmet meals, but good solid food that will satisfy even the most hungry hunter.



Well organised driven hunts can be arranged for larger groups, as well as individual hunts for red stag, fallow buck, mouflon and hind stalking.



Our Slovakian hunts for red stags, fallow buck, mouflon, roebuck, wild boar and hinds are generally arranged with private districts/hunting clubs, which range in size between 2,000 and 10,000 hectares. Depending on the size of the district's and game you wish to hunt for, you can change district from day to day, so the hunt matches the wishes of the client. There is a good chance of finding a strong trophy.

Slovakia has strong hunting traditions and they take pride in the hunting and game management. This is why Slovakia is renown for its large game populations, of all the most commonly hunted European species.

You will also be hunting in magnificent countryside, with hilly and mountainous areas that are broken up by large forests and areas of farmland - the ideal terrain for driven hunts as well as deer and mouflon hunts.
