Overview

At RH Safaris we can offer some of the best wingshooting on the continent of Africa. Hunt over more than 100,000 hectares of mainly privately owned land in South Africa, primarily south of Johannesburg. You can enjoy successful shooting for between 15 - 20 different species of pigeons, ducks, geese, guinea fowl and sandgrouse. Wing shooting at RH Safaris is managed in a very sustainable manner, and each hunting district is only hunted every 4th week.

Wingshooting can be combined with exciting hunting for more than 20 different antelope species, which also makes this tour to South Africa a really unique experience.

Our base is only a 2 hour drive by car from Johannesburg, and our safaris are arranged and carried out by a dedicated team of people who have many years of experience of wingshooting, rifle- and bow hunting.

Best period

The best period for wingshooting is from May to August.

It is not allowed to shoot waterfowl and upland birds on Sundays. It is only possible to shoot pigeons on these days.

You will be served beautifully prepared meals, featuring delicious dishes from the African kitchen, which often have game as the main ingredient.









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



More than 90% of our wingshoots takes place in Free State Province, in the regions of Vaaldam, Vaal, Vals, Wilger and Renosterriver. This area is often called South Africa's "grain barn" because of the huge amount of grain that is produced here. This is also why the area provides an absolutely ideal habitat for the many different upland birds, waterfowl, doves and pigeons, because there is more than enough cover, water, food and roosting places for them.

Pigeons arrive in thousands to feed in the fields full of ripe sunflowers. The season here stretches from February to the end of August. It is the experience of a lifetime to see so many pigeons coming from all directions and from every angle.
