

### Overview

As something quite extraordinary, our partner in Argentina now offers a "Mixed bag program", which combines different hunting experiences with fishing. Here you can hunt the lightning-fast pigeons and ducks, as well as you can fish in the unique Parana river.

When shooting pigeons the only limit is your desire to shoot. At the same time, there are also some excellent opportunities for duck hunting in the large wetlands of the region and along the Parana River.

There is something magical about Argentine duck hunting and their many brightly colored duck species. Typically, the hunt takes place in the morning, where you leave the accommodation early in the morning and head out to the hunting area, where upon arrival your guide quickly constructs a hide and lays out decoys. At dawn, you can begin to hear the ducks' wings beating in the air. Just seeing the sunrise and ducks flying over the decoys is worth the trip! In Argentina, there are quotas on ducks and it is permitted to shoot 20 ducks per hunter/day.

In addition to pigeon and duck hunting, partridge hunts are also offered with pointing dogs. Also here, there is a quota on how many birds you can shoot per day. In this region, the quota is 8 partridges per hunter/day, or max 50 shots)

As an added bonus to the many hunting opportunities, Argentina also offers some fantastic fishing. The Parana River offers the world's best freshwater fishing after the "Golden Dorado", which really offers some entertaining

fishing. There is fishing from the bank or from boats along the Parana river and it is possible to fly or spin fish according to taste and preference. If you really want serious action, "Golden Dorado" is a fish that is really up for a good fight.

Typical "Mixed bag program"

Day 1: Arrival at Estancia Cortaderas lodge. Pigeon hunting in the afternoon/evening.

Day 2: Partridge hunting in the morning and fishing in the afternoon/evening.

Day 3: Duck hunting in the morning and pigeon hunting in the afternoon/evening.

Day 4: Classic pigeon hunting for large pigeons (pigeons) with hides and decoys (bag limit of 100 per hunter/day) Day 5: Partridge hunting in the morning and fishing in the

afternoon/evening. Day 6: Duck hunting and departure from the lodge in the afternoon.

**Bag limits:** 

Partridges: there is a "bag-limit" of 8 partridges per

person/day (or max 50 shots)

Ducks: There is a "bag-limit" of 20 ducks per person/day (or

max 100 shots)

Large pigeons (Pigeons): there is a "bag-limit" of 100

"pigeons" per person/day Doves: no restrictions!

**Hunting period (high season)** 

May - August

#### Rifle hunting (optional)

In addition to the wingshooting, it is also possible to spend a few extra days on a big game hunt with a nearby outfitter - approx. 21/2 hours drive north of the lodge Estancia Cortaderas, where the bird hunt takes place. Here you can choose to spend 2-3 days and hunt some of Argentina's iconic big game species. The typical species that are

hunted are the Blackbuck antelope, Axis deer, South American water buffalo and wild boar.

The outfitter, which offers big game hunting, has approx. 40,000 ha of mixed hunting areas which mainly consist of large cattle farms. Some of the areas may be partially fenced.

When it comes to wing shooting and fishing lodges Estancia Cortaderas is one of the best in the world. The lodge is located north of Buenos Aires in the province of Entre Rios. The style of the lodge is old colonial style which recalls a bygone era yet has all the modern features of a small luxury hotel.

Estancia Cortaderas has earned a reputation as the finest hunting and fishing destination in South America. Entering the Estancia lodge you will be going through the spacious gun room. Here you will find a gun rack and storage area for every hunter. All rooms are equipped with two queen size beds, air condition, heating, private bath and patio with a fine view.

Dinner is served on fine china and linen tablecloth in the lodge's dining room. There will always be featured a three course gourmet meal. Argentines eat dinner quite a bit later than Europeans are used to, allowing for a lengthy cocktail and social time before dining. The grass fed beef which is served is among the finest quality in the world and is complemented by an array of classic continental game dishes. The gourmet chef can cook a number of argentinian specialties.









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Malalcue Lodge is the outfitter's northern lodge and is located near the town of Esquina, in the Corrientes region and overlooking the Corriente River, which flows into the Parana River just a short distance away. This beautiful lodge with 6 rooms and 5 bathrooms offers the perfect setting for the hunter. With a traditional Argentinian construction and thatched roof, this former resort was renovated and equipped to receive hunters from all over the world and from the lodge several different hunting and fishing opportunities are offered, such as big game hunting, duck hunting, partridge hunting and dorado fishing in the river.

The day at Malalcue Lodge starts with a big homemade breakfast, after which you are transported to the hunting area, where the guides have prepared everything for the hunters. Depending on the hunt, lunch is served in the field or back at the lodge.

At Malalcue Lodge, there is no exception when it comes to the meals and typical Argentinian barbecue dishes are most often served. In the evening, you can relax in front of the fireplace with a drink before dinner is served and it is not unusual for the chef to serve meat from the game you have shot on the hunt, together

with local Argentinian wines.









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

The local population of pigeons has exploded in recent years in Entre Rios province due to increased agricultural production in the area. The area has wet, green fields which are increasingly being converted to soya, maize and sorghum production. This has attracted an unusually high number of pigeons.

At the same time, there are also some excellent opportunities for duck hunting in the large wetlands of the region and along the Parana River. There are many different duck species that can be hunted, which makes the hunt very special - In Argentina there are quotas on duck hunts and it is therefore only allowed to shoot 20-25 ducks per hunter/day. In addition to pigeon and duck hunting, partridge hunts are also offered with pointing dogs.

In addition to wingshooting, big game hunting is also offered on some of the local farms in the Corrientes area. The hunt takes place on free range and the typical species are the Blackbuck antelope, Axis deer and wild boar. In addition, there is also a good population of South American water buffalo, which are also huntable.

The Parana River offers the world's best freshwater fishing after the "Golden Dorado", which really offers some entertaining fishing. There is fishing from the bank or from boats along the Parana river and it is possible to fly or spin fish according to taste and preference.

The season starts in May and ends in August.
