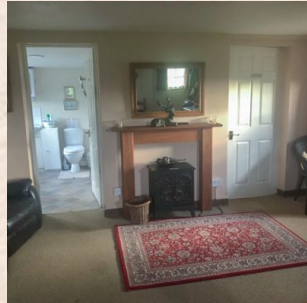

Shot trophies must be settled directly with the gamekeeper

Under 30 cm	£360,-
30-35.9 cm	£525,-
36-39.9 cm	£680,-
40-45.9 cm	£780,-
46-49.9 cm (non medal)	£840,-
50 cm and over (non medal)	£940,-

Medal Class Trophies:

Bronze 225 CIC	£1.150,-
Silver 240 CIC	£1.470,-
Gold 255 CIC	£1.780,- + £14,- pr. CIC point over 255

Abnormal trophies will be valued by the hunt manager in the district itself.

Stags wounded and not found, will be charged for according to the estimated trophy price.

It will also be possible to combine with roebucks

Shot roebucks must be settled directly with the gamekeeper.
