Red Stag Hunting in Poland

Throughout history, great deal of prestige is awarded to hunters who shoot a mature stag! The red stag is the undisputed King of Europe's game animals - the trophy which all European hunters are most keen to hang on their wall. However, it is only when you have experienced the thrill of hunting during the height of the rut, that you really understand why this is.

The red stag is powerful, graceful - even majestic - and easily the most impressive animal in our forests. It is quite natural that all European rifle hunters will want to test their skills against this game - preferably more than once!

We can offer a wide range of the very best State Forest Districts in western Poland, all of which can deliver top quality red deer hunts. These State Forest Districts all have well trained, experienced and very responsible hunting guides, who each have their own areas in the districts, which they know like the back of their own hands.

The hunt usually takes the form of stalking or lying in wait on one of the towers that have been optimally placed in each district, with regard to the deer's behavioural patterns during the rut.

You will go out hunting twice a day, once in the early morning starting before dawn, and again in the late afternoon/evening during the hours around sunset. It will often be possible to combine stag hunting with a roebuck hunt, if the district has any left on its shooting quota, or with hunting for wild boar.

Accommodation is in the district, in the traditional brick-built house which is situated next to a 30m long lake. Guest accommodation is on the first floor and consists of - in addition to a dining room - of 5 double and 1 single room, all with en suite bathroom and toilet. There is also a refrigerator at the disposal of guests. The accommodation is rated as category "S". A neighbouring house offers 3 single rooms, which are used when large groups are visiting. Guests have access to a locked garage. WiFi and mobile phone coverage are both available.













PARTHER RDLP Torun



We have worked together with the Regional Direction of State Forests in Torun –the Regionalna Dyrekcja Lasów Panstwowych we Toruniu, or in everyday language the RDLP Torun – for the last 21 years, and before that Wilson Jagtrejser (which later became Diana) worked together with some of the districts. Our partnership includes 8 state forest districts, and we have long term agreements with all 8 districts. Of the rest (= 19) of RDLP Torun's total of 27 districts, the hunting is let out to various Polish hunting associations. Some of the districts lie in the "Bory Tucholski" – Poland's biggest forest complex.

In common for all the state-owned districts under RDLP Torun, which was established in 1925 and is one of the oldest regional directions, is good, professionel and stabile game mangement, with each district having it's own speciality. Some of them stand out because of their fantastic stag hunts, others because of their well organized driven hunts - while some districts can simply do it all. More information given under the individual districts and we will of course be happy to provide more detailed information via telephone or email.

When hunting in a state-owned district accommodation is normally provided in the hunting district itself – and not in a hotel in town. In this way our customers can enjoy a"total experience". The game is usually taken back to your accommodation so your hunting companions can join the celebrations. In some districts you can lie in bed at night and listen to the red deer stags roar during the September rut.

A hunt on one of the districts under RDLP Torun is clearly a good choice!



The Zamrzenica state hunting district is 17,274 ha. in size, of which 9,700 ha. is forest and the remaining 7,574 ha. farmland, meadow, lakes and wetlands. The forest is predominantly coniferous (circa 80%), but there are also areas of oak, birch and other broadleaf trees. The district is generally flat, but some areas are slightly hilly. Zamrzenica has over 125 high seats/stands and 50 feeding places. Up to 6 hunters can be taken at a time for individual hunts, while the optimal group size for driven hunts is 10 - 12.

This district can offer hunting for roe deer, red deer, fallow deer and wild boar. Every year 85 roe bucks are taken here. Most of these trophies are under 300g net, but a number of bucks of over 300g are shot here. The annual quota for red stags is 35 - the majority have a trophy weight of 4 - 5kg. However ever year stags of over 6kg are taken here, with a few individuals achieving over 7kg - and on rare occasions 8kg. The fallow deer population is expanding rapidly with a yearly shooting plan of 20 fallow bucks, and there is a good chance of bagging a buck with a trophy weight of over 3kg. In 2016 were shot 3 fallow bucks with a trophy weight of close to 4 kg. There is also a good population of wild

boar here at Zamrzenica, and these can be shot on individual hunts throughout the season as well as on the 5 annual driven hunts, which normal produce a good mixed parade with all the different species available on show.

Zamrzenica is 275 km from the border crossing at Kolbaskowo south of Szczecin (circa 4 hours), 60km from Bydgoszcz, which is the nearest major town, and around 160km from Gdansk, where you can find the nearest international airport.
