Big Bucks in Kurgan



Overview

Big roebucks - really big roebucks! Siberian roebuck are closely related to the roebuck we have in Europe but grow much larger, both in body and trophy size. It is therefore without doubt that this exciting hunt for big Siberian roebuck during their rut, will exert a great pull on the traveling hunter with a weakness for buck hunting. A fully grown buck will typically reach a weight of between 40 - 50kg. and the average trophy weight is somewhere between 700 and 900g. Every year bucks are also taken that are well over 1,000g - a really outstanding trophy.

On this hunt it is possible to shoot more than one buck, but the number of licenses are limited so it is very important to book the number of bucks you wish to shoot when you first book your hunting tour.

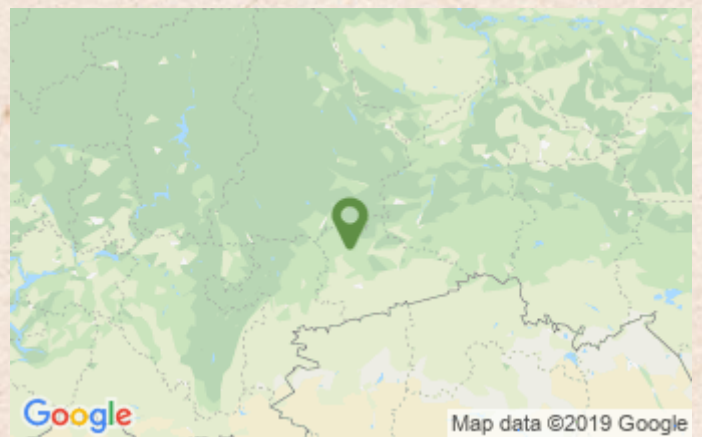
The best period to hunt is during the rut, which usually takes place from the end of August to mid September. This hunt does not present any great challenge to the hunters level of fitness - everybody can take part!

On a 5 day hunt it is a realistic target to shoot 2 - 3 bucks, and because of the selective shooting policy, it is normally 3 as the maximum number of buck a hunter will be allowed to shoot. As there are only a limited number of licenses available, it is very important to book the number of bucks you wish to shoot when you first book your hunting tour.

The best period to hunt is during the rut, which usually takes place rather later than that of the European roe deer, namely from the end of August to mid September.

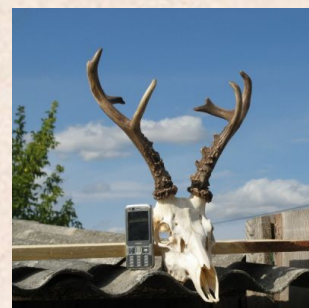
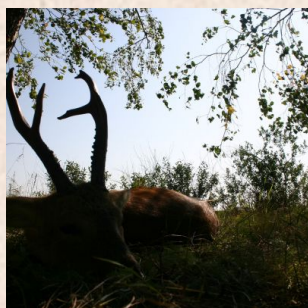
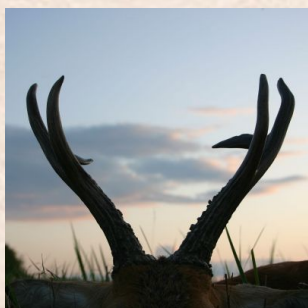
Brief Itinerary

Day 1 : Afternoon departure from Frankfurt/London, fly to Jekaterinburg via Moscow.

Day 2 : Early morning arrival in Jekaterinburg, transfer to the hunting district

Days 3 - 7 : 4 1/2 days hunting, with 1:1 guiding.

Day 8 : Transfer to Jekaterinburg and return flight via Moscow



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ACCOMMODATION Camp Kurgan



Accommodation can vary from district to district, but generally you will stay in comfortable timber huts or a local hunting cabin in the hunting district itself. Occasionally you might stay with your hunting guide. Normally you will stay in a twin-room, and the house will also offer a sitting room and a bathroom. Accommodation includes full-board: breakfast, lunch and dinner. Don't expect haute-cuisine, but you will enjoy good, nourishing meals. Normally a maximum of four hunters will stay in a hunting camp, larger groups will be split up between different camps.



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PARTNER Partner in Russia



Our partner in Russia is one of the largest, most reputable and longest established outfitters in this huge country. They can offer hunts for all the many game species it is legal to hunt in this country, from spring hunts for capercaillie and black grouse near Kirov, to autumn hunts for the huge Kamchatka moose.

This company, which has its headquarters in Moscow, was founded by a professionally qualified game-biologist, shortly after the fall of the Berlin Wall in 1989. Since its foundation the company has developed and maintained a very professional hunting organization.

When you arrive at your destination airport in Russia, one of their employees will be waiting to meet you, and help with immigration formalities, take care of transfers to the domestic airport or further on to the hunting district itself. During the hunt there will always be an English speaking guide in the main camp. They have skilled interpreters and support staff, they employ excellent local hunting guides, and generally maintain a high level of service. They will of course also take care of all the paperwork associated with the hunt, such as hunting licenses, Russian weapons permits,

veterinarian- and CITES documentation, and shipment of trophies back home etc..

Their hunting camps vary from very comfortable lodges to very simple tent camps or small hunts, all depending of where and for which species you are hunting. In general they make a great effort to ensure your stay is as pleasant as at all possible.

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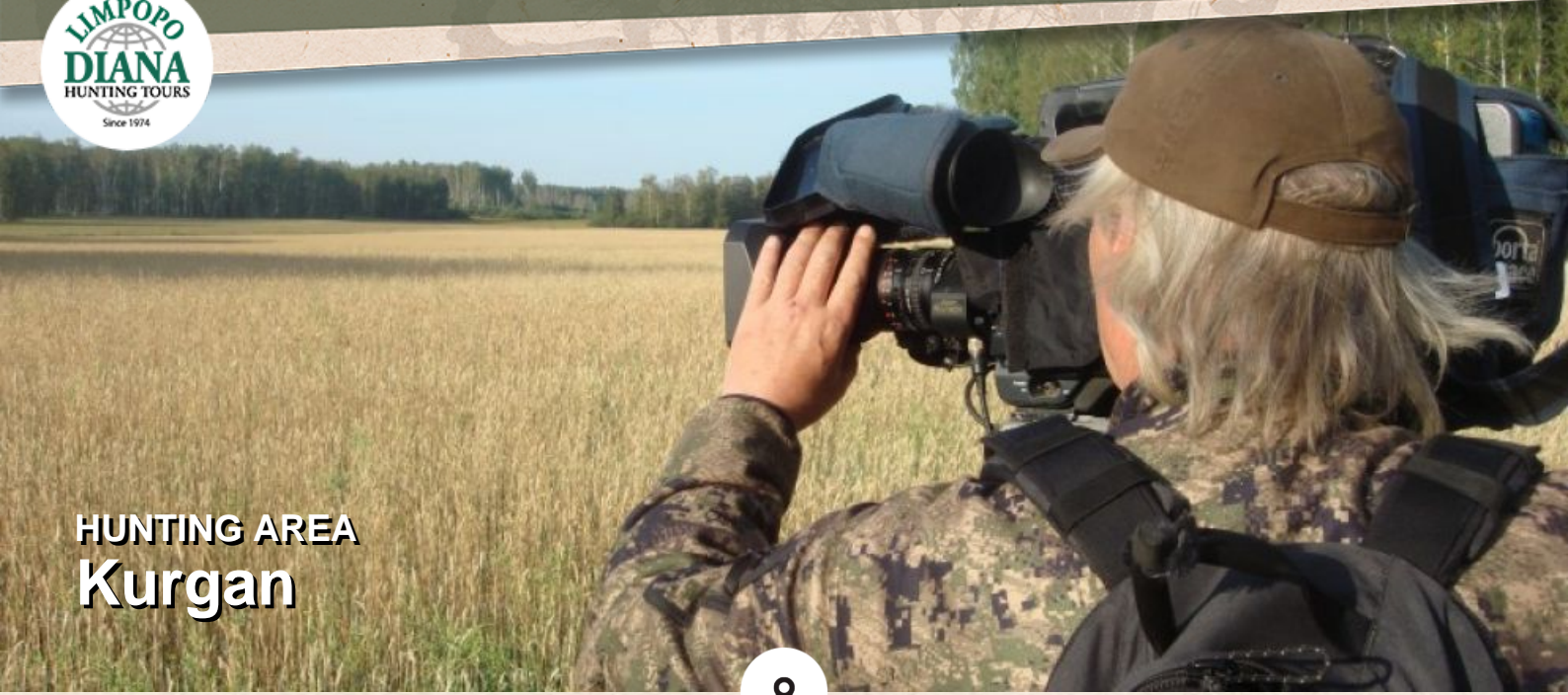
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HUNTING AREA Kurgan



The terrain is relatively flat, but still rather varied consisting of large fields of various crops, woods and forest, wetlands and hedgerows: an ideal habitat for roe deer. The hunting will be carried out as a combination of stalking, lying in wait and driving in 4WD vehicles. The roe deer are generally dispersed more sparsely than in Europe, and because of the greater distances involved you should be prepared for a certain amount of driving. Hunt guiding is 1:1, there is space for up to 4 hunters on the individual districts.

Trophies will be weighed 24 hours after boiling. If a buck is shot very late in the hunt so that there is no time to let it dry, 3% will be deducted from the trophy weight.

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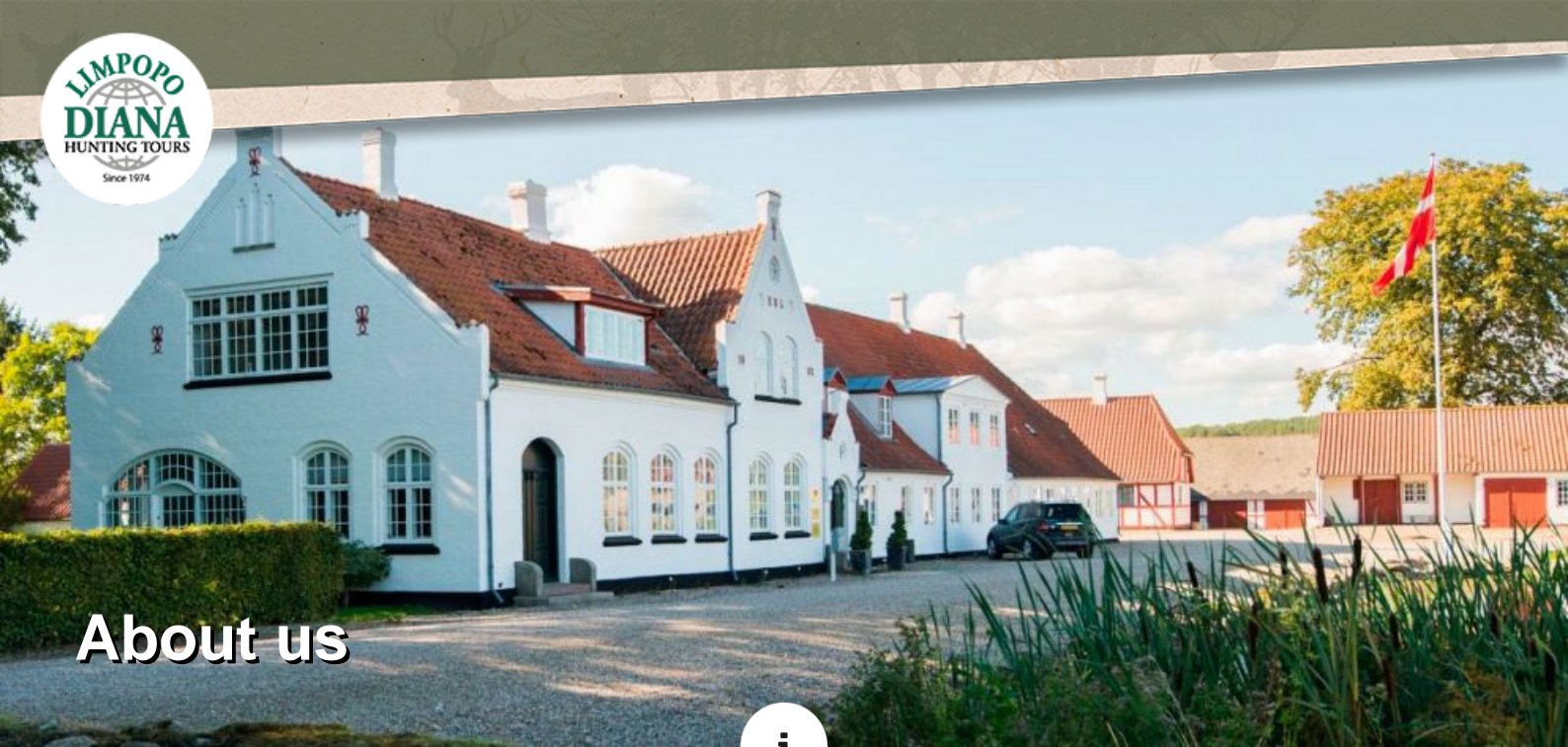
