

# Combination Hunt in British Columbia



### Overview

The hunting district lies next to the River Yukon on British Columbia's northern border. Hundreds of kilometers away from civilisation, travelling to these districts is like travelling back in time. With large populations of game animals and excellent trophy quality, this hunting district is unlike any other place in North America. You don't need to move far from camp to hunt moose, caribou, mountain goat or wild sheep. This possibility of hunting so many species from a single place is unique.


This district is more than just a place with rich animal life and big trophies, the scenery here is also absolutely beautiful.

The largest Canadian Moose are found in northern British Columbia. After crossing the Yukon border, the moose are considered to be Alaska Yukon Moose, however many of the moose found in this hunting district carry Yukon Moose genes but are geographically considered for Canadian Moose, meaning this area harbours some of the largest Canadian moose found anywhere.

Some district have large numbers of moose, but are largely forested, which makes finding and hunting them very difficult. This beautiful district is largely open, which makes it possible to scout over large areas.

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Hunting from horseback also makes it possible to cover more than one district. Our hunters can expect to see plenty of animal life, and to quickly fulfil their hunting dreams.

This hunting area can also offer fantastic hunting for mountain goat, in a remote area with a good and healthy mountain goat population, which can also deliver some strong trophies.

Last, but not least, our hunters can experience staying in a hunting camp with an infrastructure unlike any other camp in a remote part of Canada.

The district's 3 base camps can offer spacious heated cabins, good bathroom facilities, separate cabins for guides and hunters, and even Wi-Fi. Our hunters can enjoy a good breakfast every morning and a filling homemade dinner in the evening after a hard day's hunting. Even the districts more remote spike camps have cabins heated with wood burning stoves, or large heated wall tents and bathroom facilities.



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## ACCOMMODATION Whitehorse




Book flights to Whitehorse in Yukon: you should plan your trip to ensure you arrive here the day before you will take a charter flight out to the hunting district. We would be happy to book hotels for our guests here, allowing them to spend the night in Whitehorse and ensure that all their baggage and weapons have arrived safely.

On the morning of your planned charter flight, you will have to take a taxi to the company's airport where an Alpine Aviation Charter aircraft will be waiting to fly you to the northern British Columbia, where you will find the hunting district and the three basecamps. On arrival your guide and wrangler will bid you welcome and help you with everything during your whole stay.

The three base camps in the area feature cozy heated cabins, spacious cook houses with full kitchens, hot showers, separate guide cabins and even WiFi. Our hunters enjoy a hot breakfast each morning and a home-cooked dinner each night. Even our spike camps have wood-stove heated cabins or wall tents with propane cook stoves and bag showers.

These features make the spike camps more comfortable than the base camps at many other operations.

From your initial charter flight into camp and throughout your stay, you will be greeted with impeccable hospitality, incredible scenery and outstanding hunting !



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
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# PARTNER KAWDY Outfitters

# Northern British Columbia



The hunting district itself lies on British Columbia's northern border next to the River Yukon, whose source is actually British Columbia's Lake Atlin. The hunting district is hundreds of kilometers from the nearest outposts of civilisation, which means our hunters will find the ultimate wilderness adventure waiting for them here.

After arrival in the city of Whitehorse in Alaska, the hunting adventure begins with a charter flight to northern British Columbia. The hunters are flown out to one of the fantastic hunting base camps found in this district. Here they will find heated cabins, a fully equipped kitchen which serves home-made food, hot showers and hospitable, experienced staff.

After a hot breakfast, you will leave camp on horseback around the break of dawn, in the company of your guide and wrangler. The hunt now begins in earnest. You can expect to spend a couple of hours in the saddle every day, but this can vary depending on where you spot game and on what your guide's plans for the day are. For hunters who would prefer not to hunt on horseback, or perhaps would simply like to experience something

else, it is also possible to hunt moose from a boat on some of the large lakes found in the district.

With large populations of game animals and excellent trophy quality, this hunting district is unlike any other place in North America. You don't need to move far from camp to hunt moose, caribou, mountain goat or wild sheep. This possibility of hunting so many species from a single place is unique.

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

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
