Hind Hunting in Poland

To creep slowly into shooting range of a herd of red deer hinds is anything but easy. There are always alert pairs of eyes and ears amongst them. When you manage to actually do so, a hunter's feeling of success is absolute...

An important part of game management practices is to cull hinds and calves/lambs each and every year. A large proportion of these are shot during individual hunts. This type of hunting is, thanks to the very low trophy fees, very reasonable but the challenge of getting the better of the watchful hinds is, as a rule, at least as great as that of shooting a roaring stag on a trophy hunt.

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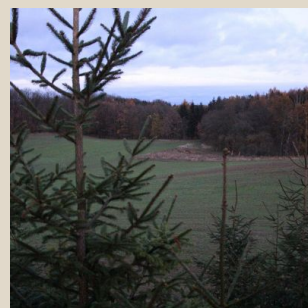


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The hunt usually takes the form of stalking or lying in wait on one of the towers that have been optimally placed in each district, with regard to the deer's behavioural patterns. You will go out hunting twice a day, once in the early morning starting before dawn, and again in the late afternoon/evening during the hours around sunset.

Mangy hunters often regularly take part in hind stalking with a couple of good comrades. This makes a good tradition, which will help polish your hunting skills at a very reasonable price!



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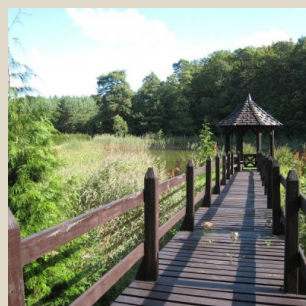
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ACCOMMODATION

Accommodation - Chojna



Accommodation takes place in a lovely hunting lodge in the heart of the district. While it is not a luxurious place, everything is as it should be, and the catering is very good. Our guests stay in one part of the house, while the hunting guide, Marek, resides in the other part. Marek speaks English and ensures that everything runs smoothly. 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PARTNER RDLP Szczecin



Our partnership with the Regional Direction of State Forests in Szczecin – the Regionalna Dyrekcja Lasów Państwowych we Szczecinie, or in everyday language the RDLP Szczecin – dates back to 1982, when we first started to send hunters to one of their districts. More districts were added later, and now in 2016 we have long term contracts with 4 of the best state-owned districts. Of the rest (= 31) of their total of 35 district, the hunting has been let out to various Polish hunting associations, except for 5, which are sold via other agencies.

In common for all the state-owned districts under RDLP Szczecin, which was established in 1978, is good, professional and stabile game mangement, with each district having it's own speciality. Some of them stand out because of their fantastic stag hunts, others because of their well organized driven hunts - while some districts can simply do it all. More information given under the individual districts, and we will of course be happy to provide more detailed information via telephone or email.

When hunting in a state-owned district accommodation is normally provided in the hunting district itself – and not in a hotel

in town. In this way our customers can enjoy a "total experience". The game is usually taken back to your accommodation so your hunting companions can join the celebrations. In some districts you can lie in bed at night and listen to the red deer stags roar during the September rut.

A hunt on one of the districts under RDLP Szczecin is clearly a good choice!

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HUNTING AREA Chojna



Our Chojna hunting district covers a total area of 13,820 hectares, of which 9,354 hectares are forest, while the remaining 4,466 hectares consist of agricultural land, meadows, and lakes. The forest is primarily made up of coniferous forest (76%), but also includes 5% beech, 9% oak, and the rest is mixed deciduous trees. The area is predominantly flat, with some lightly hilly terrain. Chojna has 40 high seats, as well as 10 feeding places. It can accommodate up to 4-5 hunters at a time for individual hunting, while the optimal number for driven hunts is 12-15 hunters.

Chojna is home to good populations of red deer and fallow deer, which attract hunters back year after year. The red deer hunting is particularly attractive, with an annual quota of around 22 stags, most of which have antler weights around 6 kg, but there is also the chance to shoot impressive stags weighing up to 8-9 kg. The fallow deer population is unfortunately declining due to wolves, but the district still offers a very good fallow deer hunt, with 12 fallow deer harvested annually, having antler weights between 2.50-3.20 kg. There are also some roe deer in Chojna, but the population is modest, with around 8 bucks shot each year.

Although the wild boar population has been challenged by African swine fever, it is now improving – so much so that we are excited to offer 2 exciting driven hunts in the 2025/26 season, expecting a good mixed parade of all game species.

Chojna is located 25 km from the border crossing at Schwedt south of Szczecin, 70 km from Szczecin, the nearest larger city, 100 km from Szczecin/Goleniow airport, and 130 km from Berlin airport.
