## **Hind Hunting in Poland**

To creep slowly into shooting range of a herd of red deer hinds is anything but easy. There are always alert pairs of eyes and ears amongst them. When you manage to actually do so, a hunter's feeling of success is absolute...

The hunt usually takes the form of stalking or lying in wait on one of the towers that have been optimally placed in each district, with regard to the deer's behavioural patterns. You will go out hunting twice a day, once in the early morning starting before dawn, and again in the late afternoon/evening during the hours around sunset.

Mangy hunters often regularly take part in hind stalking with a couple of good comrades. This makes a good tradition, which will help polish your hunting skills at a very reasonable price!

Our hunters stay in a recently renovated house in the hunting district, hosted by the gamekeeper Tomasz Karp and his wife. Tomasz can speak German, while his wife speaks English. Guest accommodation is on the ground and first floors, while the gamekeeper's family lives on the second floor. The guest rooms comprise of - in addition to a cosy sitting room with a fireplace - 5 double rooms and 4 single rooms (all with bathroom/toilet), a billiards room in the cellar, a drying room for wet clothes and boots, and a weapon safe are available for all guests. The accommodation is rated as category "S". WiFi is available but no stabile mobile phone coverage.

# PARTHER RDLP Wrocleiw



The Regional Direction of State Forests in Wroc?aw –the Regionalna Dyrekcja Lasów Panstwowych we Wroc?awiu, or in everyday speech the RDLP Wroc?aw - is our longest standing partner in Poland. We have been sending hunters to the districts managed by RDLP Wroclaw since 1978, when we used one of the districts. Now we use a total of 11 state owned districts, of which we have long term contracts with 6 of the very best. On the rest (= 22) of their total of 33 districts, the hunting is let out to various Polish hunting associations.

In common for all the state-owned districts under RDLP Wroc?aw, which in 2015 could celebrate it's 70th anniversary, is good, professionel and stabile game mangement, with each district having it's own speciality. Some of them stand out because of their fantastic stag hunts, others because of their well organized driven hunts - while some districts can simply do it all. More information given under the individual districts and we will of course be happy to provide more detailed information via telephone or email.

When hunting in a state-owned district accommodation is

normally provided in the hunting district itself – and not in a hotel in town. In this way our customers can enjoy a"total experience". The game is usually taken back to your accommodation so your hunting companions can join the celebrations. In some districts you can lie in bed at night and listen to the red deer stags roar during the September rut.

A hunt on one of the districts under RDLP Wroclaw is clearly a good choice!

The Jawor state hunting district covers a total of 10,229 ha. of which 5,994 ha. is forest, while the remaining 4,235 ha. consists of farmland and meadow. The forest is made up of 55% oak and 30% conifer, but there are also areas of birch, beech, alder and aspen. The district is partly flat and partly hilly (up to 600m above sea level). Jawor has 121 high seats/stands and 29 feeding places. The district can take 3 - 4 hunters at a time for individual hunts, while driven hunts can be arranged for groups of 10 - 14 hunters.

This district can offer roe deer, red deer, wild boar and mouflon. The annual bag of roe deer here is around 45. The trophy size for the majority of the bucks is under 350g, but bucks of over 350g are taken here. There is an annual quota of 16 red stags - the majority of which produce trophies of between 4 to 6.5kg, however stags of up to 8kg - and even over - are taken more or less every year. Jawor has a dense population of wild boar, which can be hunted on individual hunts throughout the season, as well as on the 5 driven hunts that are organised during the autumn and winter. Jawor is also home to Poland's largest free living population of mouflon, of which we can sell 15 mouflon rams each

year, naturally as well as ewes and lambs.

Jawor is 160km from the border crossing at Forst/Olszyna, 10 km from the town of Jawor,30km from Legnica, which is the closest major town, and 75km from Wroclaw which is the closest international airport.
