Driven Hunting in Poland

The sound of yapping dogs approaches, the beaters enthusiastic cries tell you that a group of boars is approaching the line of guns. You can hear the rustle of dry leaves, and feel your pulse throb in your temple. Here they come!...

Driven hunts gets into your blood - and for many hunters Poland is permanently linked to their annual hunt on their regular district, where they are coming year after year. That the number of regular customers is as high as it is, is simply due to the quality of these hunts on our many Stateowned districts.

We have access to a wide range of the very best State Forest Districts in western Poland, of which the vast majority offer top quality driven hunting. These State Forest Districts all have well trained, experienced and very responsible hunting personnel, who all have a job connected to the district.

The hunt starts with a briefing around dawn, where the head gamekeeper tells about how the hunt will progress, and inform you about the safety procedures during the hunt. Normally our driven hunting packages take place over 3-4 days and include 3 days of hunting. Typically between 12-14 guns are needed to sufficiently cover the drives. Between 8 - 10 drives are carried out every day, from early in the morning to late in the afternoon. The areas driven are selected in advance, taking into account game movements in the district.

For many hunters driven hunts are the ultimate form of rifle



PARTMER RDLP Szczecin



Our partnership with the Regional Direction of State Forests in Szczecin – the Regionalna Dyrekcja Lasów Pa?stwowych we Szczecinie, or in everyday language the RDLP Szczecin – dates back to 1982, when we first started to send hunters to one of their districts. More districts were added later, and now in 2016 we have long term contracts with 4 of the best state-owned districts. Of the rest (= 31) of their total of 35 district, the hunting has been let out to various Polish hunting associations, except for 5, which are sold via other agencies.

In common for all the state-owned districts under RDLP Szczecin, which was established in 1978, is good, professionel and stabile game mangement, with each district having it's own speciality. Some of them stand out because of their fantastic stag hunts, others because of their well organized driven hunts - while some districts can simply do it all. More information given under the individual districts, and we will of course be happy to provide more detailed information via telephone or email.

When hunting in a state-owned district accommodation is normally provided in the hunting district itself – and not in a hotel

in town. In this way our customers can enjoy a"total experience". The game is usually taken back to your accommodation so your hunting companions can join the celebrations. In some districts you can lie in bed at night and listen to the red deer stags roar during the September rut.

A hunt on one of the districts under RDLP Szczecin is clearly a good choice!

The Kliniska state hunting covers a total of 16,589 ha. of which 12,611ha. are forest and the remaining 3,978 ha. is farmland and meadow. The forest is largely coniferous (86%). The district is generally flat. Kliniska offers more than 85 high seats and stands together with 32 feeding places. Individual hunts can be arranged for up to 6 hunters at a time, however the optimal number is 4 hunters. Driven hunts can be arranged for groups of 12 - 14 hunters.

The district offers hunting for roe deer, red deer and wild boar, with red deer being the most important species with an annual quota of close to 200 deer. 40 roebuck are shot here annually. Most trophies are less that 280g in net weight, but bucks of over 300g are taken. The annual quota for red stags is 25 - by far the most of which have a trophy weight of between 5-6 kg, with some trophies over 7kg and occasionally an individual of 8-9 kg are produced from time to time. Kliniska has a good population of wild boar, and these are hunted on individual hunts throughout the season, and on the 4 driven hunts carried out during the autumn and winter.

Kliniska is 40 km from the border crossing at Kolbaskowo (Szczecin), 30km from Szczecin which is the nearest large town and 25km from the airport at Goleniow.
