











Fallow Buck Hunting in Poland

Deep grunts rip through the silence of the richly coloured autumnal forest. The big, mature fallow buck are fighting a fierce battle to win the favours of the hinds. The excitement in the air feels electric ...

The fallow buck hunts usually take place during the rutting season, which normally occurs from mid-October to the start of November. Hunting during the rutting season for the grunting bucks is just as intense and exciting as a red stag hunt, and carried out in the same way, a blend of stalking and lying in wait.

Even though the fallow bucks are quite a bit smaller than red stag, you will not notice the difference! The deep growls and the dramatic fights between the territorial fallow bucks characterise the vivid scenes of the rut.

In Poland fallow buck hunts take place exclusively in the open countryside - hunting in fenced enclosures is prohibited by Polish hunting legislation. Because of strict, long term game management policies, fallow deer are becoming more and more widespread, and in many places the populations are dense. This helps to make the experience of stalking them on their rutting grounds a really intense experience!

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The hunt usually takes the form of stalking or lying in wait on one of the towers that have been optimally placed in each district, with regard to the deer's behavioural patterns during the rut. You will go out hunting twice a day, once in the early morning starting before dawn, and again in the late afternoon/evening during the hours around sunset.

It will always be possible to combine your hunt for fallow buck with hunting for hinds and wild boar, once you have shot your buck.

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Hunters stay with a young couple in a privately owned house in the village of Chojno, which is close to Brodnica. The house is surrounded by a large, very nice garden. Guests stay on the first floor, where there are 4 triple rooms available. All rooms have a bathroom and toilet. WiFi is available and there is mobile phone coverage. Guests also have access to a locked garage and store room. The game keeper is Hubert Malina (who speaks good English), and he and his team of guides are very talented and professional .The town of Brodnica, which is only 15 minutes away by car, is well worth a visit. There is a lovely town square, and good shopping.









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PARTHER RDLP Torun



We have worked together with the Regional Direction of State Forests in Torun –the Regionalna Dyrekcja Lasów Panstwowych we Toruniu, or in everyday language the RDLP Torun – for the last 21 years, and before that Wilson Jagtrejser (which later became Diana) worked together with some of the districts. Our partnership includes 8 state forest districts, and we have long term agreements with all 8 districts. Of the rest (= 19) of RDLP Torun's total of 27 districts, the hunting is let out to various Polish hunting associations. Some of the districts lie in the "Bory Tucholski" – Poland's biggest forest complex.

In common for all the state-owned districts under RDLP Torun, which was established in 1925 and is one of the oldest regional directions, is good, professionel and stabile game mangement, with each district having it's own speciality. Some of them stand out because of their fantastic stag hunts, others because of their well organized driven hunts - while some districts can simply do it all. More information given under the individual districts and we will of course be happy to provide more detailed information via telephone or email.

When hunting in a state-owned district accommodation is normally provided in the hunting district itself – and not in a hotel in town. In this way our customers can enjoy a"total experience". The game is usually taken back to your accommodation so your hunting companions can join the celebrations. In some districts you can lie in bed at night and listen to the red deer stags roar during the September rut.

A hunt on one of the districts under RDLP Torun is clearly a good choice!




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The Brodnica state hunting district in northern Poland covers a total area of 9,690 ha. of which 2,613 is woodland, while the remaining 7,077 ha. consists of farmland, meadows, lakes, rivers and streams. The woodland is largely Scots pine (70%), but there is also oak (10%), beech (10%), birch (5%) and alder (5%) - a nice mixture of many different species. The district is generally flat and it is divided by a number of rivers and streams, but part of the district is slightly hilly. Brodnica has 43 high seats/stands and 12 feeding places. It is also possible to carry out an exciting hunt from a horse drawn wagon, provided it is booked in advance. The district can cater for up to 4 individual hunters at a time. Driven hunts are carried out with groups of 8 - 12 hunters.

On this district you can find red deer, roe deer, fallow deer and wild boar. 60 roe bucks are shot here annually. Trophy weights here are above average, and it is possible to shoot good bucks of over 350g. Bucks of over 400g net can also be found here. There is an annual quota of 8 red stags the majority of which have a trophy weight of

5 -7 kg. The population of fallow deer is increasing and around 10 bucks are shot here annually, all with nice trophies of around

2.5kg. Brodnica has a fine population of wild boar which can be hunted on individual hunts throughout the year and on small driven-/driven hunts in the autumn and winter. It is also possible to arrange combination hunts.

Brodnica is 380km from the border crossing at Kolbaskowo south of Szczecin, around 60km from Torun, and around 55km from Grudziadz which is nearest major town. The closest international airport is Gdansk, 180km away, while Warsaw airport is 210 km away.


