Hunt for Bezoar in Turkey

Overview

Are you a mountain hunter? If so, then the challenging hunt for the biggest ibex of them all - the Bezoar ibex - will certainly be just to your taste! A big ibex buck can carry a trophy that measures from 90cm right up to 135cm.

Turkey is one of the very few countries where it is possible to hunt the Bezoar ibex and our partner has some first class concessions around Antalya and in eastern Turkey. The rut, which takes place in November and December, is the favourite period for many hunters, but practical experience over the last few seasons has also taught us that you can also enjoy great hunting in January.

It goes without saying that mountain hunting requires the hunter to be in good physical condition.

The hunting periods are from August 1st until December 31st and from the 1st of January until the 31st of March. The rutting period in November and December are many hunters preferred period, but the period from January to March has also shown very good results. August and September can be a difficult hunting period as the ibex in these warm months go higher into the mountains.

Our hunters fly to Istanbul and from there they take a domestic flight. Here the hunters will be picked up at the airport by a representative from our business partner and driven to the hunting area.

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ACCOMMODATION

Accommodation - Bezoar Hunting in Turkey

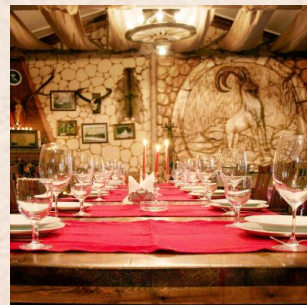
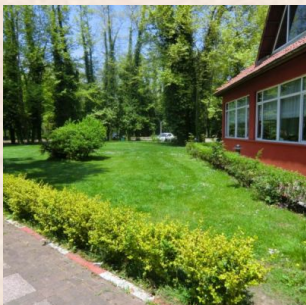


Often when hunting Bezoar Ibex in Turkey you will be relatively far away from major towns, which is where you will only, as is generally the case in Turkey, find hotels of an international standard. Therefore you will often stay in a pension or a small hotel close to the hunting district. They will either be situated in a small town or out in the countryside. Do not expect luxury accommodation, but the accommodation is clean and tidy and with a private bathroom and toilet. During your hunt accommodation on a half board basis is included. Breakfast and dinner will be taken in your hotel, and a light picnic lunch will be taken sometime during your hunt. Meals will typically be traditional Turkish dishes, and naturally, no pork will be served while you are in Turkey.

From time to time the hunt might take place high up in the mountains, making it logistically far too difficult to come down from the hills every evening, so you will sleep either in a very simple mountain hut, a small tented camp, or in a cave up in the mountains. Meals will also be prepared in the field, and we recommend you bring along a sleeping bag and insulation mat. You will of course be informed before departure if you be sleeping

up in the mountains in this way. We can also, if desired, arrange a tour on which you will be sleeping "up in the mountains" throughout your hunt.

Prices are based on accommodation in a shared double room so if, for whatever reason, you sleep in a single room, a single room supplement will be charged.



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PARTNER Gönye

Our partner in Turkey, Gönye Hunting Activities is one of the very biggest and most important players in the Turkish hunting market. They have their headquarters in the city of Konya in central Turkey, and in 2017 will be celebrating their 20 year jubilee. Over this period they have built up a large, professional organization with good hunting guides, interpreters, drivers etc. We have been working with Gönye since 2008. Generally their hunting guides are very experienced and have a thorough knowledge of the districts they are hunting in. Some of them speak a little English or German, but you should not expect too much of your guide when it comes to language skills.

When it comes to hunting for Anatolian wild boar Gönye can offer hunting over an impressive total of circa 3 million hectares in 15 different regions of Turkey, where they can arrange both individual hunts and driven hunts. They can also offer a further 11 different districts in the Taurus Mountains where you can hunt for the very attractive bezoar ibex. On top of this they can offer hunting for the rare Konya sheep, Anatolian roebuck and red stag, Anatolian gazelle and Anatolian chamois. When hunting in Turkey guiding is more or less always 1:1, with the exception of driven

hunts.

Generally it has to be said that when you hunt in Turkey you will be met by great friendliness and hospitality from your Turkish hosts, but it is also important that you are prepared to meet a very different culture and altitude to life than you might be used to.



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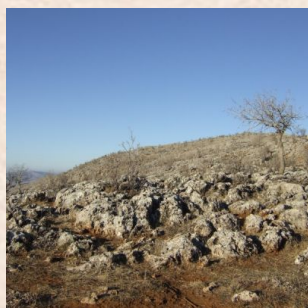
HUNTING AREA Bezoar



Our partner has a lot of different hunting areas. The areas in the eastern Taurus Mountains are located 150-300 km from Adana Airport and the hunt takes place in 1500-2600 m altitude.

The western Taurus Mountains, located relatively close to Antalya and the hunting grounds are located 50-280 km from Antalya airport. Here, there are hunting areas with various difficulty. Some areas are physically more strenuous than others.

Finally, our partner has hunting areas in the northeastern part of the Black Sea region, also located in 1500-2600 meters altitude. These areas are opened for hunting within in recent years, and has also produced really fine trophies.
