

Mouflon Hunting in Poland

A big mouflon ram is a trophy which deserves to hang on every European rifle hunter's wall! Poland is a well know destination for hunting Europe's only wild sheep, and the hunting in Poland is ALWAYS in the open countryside. In our districts you can find mouflon belonging to all trophy classes.

Mouflon have their origins in the Mediterranean region, in fact you can still find an original population of these sheep on the island of Corsica. From here this species was introduced over a large part of central Europe, where it really thrives in the vast forests found in this area.

We have access to some of the very best State Forest Districts in south west Poland, which offer top quality mouflon hunting. These State Forest Districts all have well trained, experienced and very responsible hunting guides, who each have their own areas in the districts, which they know like the back of their own hands.

The hunt usually takes the form of stalking or lying in wait on one of the towers that have been optimally placed in each district, with regard to the mouflon's behavioural patterns. The hunting season for mouflon rams is from October to the end of February.

If you want to be certain of shooting a ram carrying its handsome, dark winter coat, you should plan your hunt for the end of November or later. You will normally go hunting twice a day, in the early morning and evening, but it sometimes occurs that you will hunt all day, virtually without pause. In most cases it will be possible to combine

In Poland mouflon are only found in the open countryside, as hunting in enclosed areas is not allowed under Polish hunting legislation. We are proud to offer some very exciting hunting for this wary and alert wild sheep, and our districts can offer a wide range of different trophy quality.

Our hunters stay in a recently renovated house in the hunting district, hosted by the gamekeeper Tomasz Karp and his wife. Tomasz can speak German, while his wife speaks English. Guest accommodation is on the ground and first floors, while the gamekeeper's family lives on the second floor. The guest rooms comprise of - in addition to a cosy sitting room with a fireplace - 5 double rooms and 4 single rooms (all with bathroom/toilet), a billiards room in the cellar, a drying room for wet clothes and boots, and a weapon safe are available for all guests. The accommodation is rated as category "S". WiFi is available but no stabile mobile phone coverage.

RDLP Mrocisim



The Regional Direction of State Forests in Wroc?aw –the Regionalna Dyrekcja Lasów Panstwowych we Wroc?awiu, or in everyday speech the RDLP Wroc?aw - is our longest standing partner in Poland. We have been sending hunters to the districts managed by RDLP Wroclaw since 1978, when we used one of the districts. Now we use a total of 11 state owned districts, of which we have long term contracts with 6 of the very best. On the rest (= 22) of their total of 33 districts, the hunting is let out to various Polish hunting associations.

In common for all the state-owned districts under RDLP Wroc?aw, which in 2015 could celebrate it's 70th anniversary, is good, professionel and stabile game mangement, with each district having it's own speciality. Some of them stand out because of their fantastic stag hunts, others because of their well organized driven hunts - while some districts can simply do it all. More information given under the individual districts and we will of course be happy to provide more detailed information via telephone or email.

When hunting in a state-owned district accommodation is

normally provided in the hunting district itself – and not in a hotel in town. In this way our customers can enjoy a"total experience". The game is usually taken back to your accommodation so your hunting companions can join the celebrations. In some districts you can lie in bed at night and listen to the red deer stags roar during the September rut.

A hunt on one of the districts under RDLP Wroclaw is clearly a good choice!

Our state hunting district, Jawor, covers a total area of 10,229 hectares. The landscape is diverse, with 5,994 hectares of forest, while the remaining 4,235 hectares consist of agricultural land and lush meadows. The forest is composed of 55% oak and 30% coniferous trees, along with birch, beech, alder, and aspen. The terrain is partly flat and partly hilly, reaching elevations of up to 600 meters above sea level. Jawor has 121 high seats, as well as 29 feeding places. Up to four hunters can participate in individual hunts at a time, while the exciting driven hunts are conducted for groups of 10 to 14 hunters.

The district is home to roe deer, red deer, wild boar, and mouflon, as well as a small population of fallow deer. Around 70 roe bucks are shot each year. Most trophies weigh less than 350 grams net, but a significant number exceeds 350 grams, with some even surpassing 400 grams. The annual red deer quota is approximately 50 stags—most with a trophy weight of 5 to 7 kg, though stags reaching up to 8 kg are recorded almost every year. The district maintains a healthy population of wild boar, which are hunted both individually throughout the season and during the four driven hunts held in autumn and winter.



Mouflon are also present in Jawor, but their numbers are under pressure due to wolves in the area. As a result, only four rams are available for hunting per season, and no ewes or lambs are taken. The trophy size of the harvested rams ranges from 60 to 95 cm in horn length, with good chances of strong rams exceeding 80 cm.

Accommodation is provided in a beautiful hunting lodge located directly within the district. Guests are treated to delicious meals. The lodge has rooms on both the ground and first floors, offering five double rooms and four single rooms, all with private bathrooms. A cozy lounge with a fireplace provides a comfortable gathering space. In the basement, guests will find a billiard room, a large drying area for wet clothing and boots, and a personal gun safe for each visitor. The lodge has Wi-Fi, though mobile coverage is limited.

The head of hunting operations is Tomek, who has worked in the district for more than 30 years and manages all aspects of the hunt with great professionalism.
