We can offer a wide range of the very best State Forest Districts in western Poland, all of which can deliver top quality red deer hunts. These State Forest Districts all have well trained, experienced and very responsible hunting guides, who each have their own areas in the districts, which they know like the back of their own hands.

The hunt usually takes the form of stalking or lying in wait on one of the towers that have been optimally placed in each district, with regard to the deer's behavioural patterns during the rut.

You will go out hunting twice a day, once in the early morning starting before dawn, and again in the late afternoon/evening during the hours around sunset. It will often be possible to combine stag hunting with a roebuck hunt, if the district has any left on its shooting quota, or with hunting for wild boar.

The Regional Direction of State Forests in Wroc?aw –the Regionalna Dyrekcja Lasów Panstwowych we Wroc?awiu, or in everyday speech the RDLP Wroc?aw - is our longest standing partner in Poland. We have been sending hunters to the districts managed by RDLP Wroclaw since 1978, when we used one of the districts. Now we use a total of 11 state owned districts, of which we have long term contracts with 6 of the very best. On the rest (= 22) of their total of 33 districts, the hunting is let out to various Polish hunting associations.

In common for all the state-owned districts under RDLP Wroc?aw, which in 2015 could celebrate it's 70th anniversary, is good, professionel and stabile game mangement, with each district having it's own speciality. Some of them stand out because of their fantastic stag hunts, others because of their well organized driven hunts - while some districts can simply do it all. More information given under the individual districts and we will of course be happy to provide more detailed information via telephone or email.

When hunting in a state-owned district accommodation is

normally provided in the hunting district itself – and not in a hotel in town. In this way our customers can enjoy a"total experience". The game is usually taken back to your accommodation so your hunting companions can join the celebrations. In some districts you can lie in bed at night and listen to the red deer stags roar during the September rut.

A hunt on one of the districts under RDLP Wroclaw is clearly a good choice!

The Milicz 45 and 67 hunting districts are located in the southwest of Poland, northeast of the city of Wroc?aw. Milicz 45 covers an area of 6,319 hectares, of which 2,032 hectares are forest, while the remaining 4,287 hectares consist of agricultural land, lush meadows, and beautiful lakes. The forest is primarily coniferous (85%) with some alder trees (6%). The area is mainly flat. Milicz 45 has 79 high seats, as well as 17 feeding places. Milicz 67 covers a total area of 10,015 hectares, with 5,665 hectares of forest and the remaining 4,350 hectares made up of agricultural land, meadows, and lakes. The forest is mainly coniferous (72%), with oak (12%) and beech (9%) trees. The area is also mainly flat. Milicz 67 has 122 high seats, as well as 27 feeding places. Up to 6-7 hunters can hunt at a time, and driven hunts are arranged for groups of 10-14 hunters.

A special feature of the area (especially the Milicz 45 part) is the artificially created lakes, which are drained every year in October in rotation to harvest the carp. When the water is drained, a world of tracks from red deer and wild boar is revealed.

The districts are home to roe deer, red deer, wild boar, and a

small population of fallow deer. Each year, a total of 70 roe bucks are harvested from the two districts. Trophy-wise, most of the bucks weigh under 350 grams net, but some bucks are shot weighing over 350 grams – and some even over 400 grams. The annual red deer quota is about 35 stags – most of them with a trophy weight of 5-7 kg, but stags weighing over 7-8 kg are also found. Wild boar are hunted both during individual hunts throughout the season and on the driven hunts in the autumn and winter months.

Accommodation is provided directly in the Milicz 67 part of the district. The guest area on the first floor consists of 5 double rooms and 4 single rooms, all with their own toilet and bathroom. On the ground floor, there is a dining room with a refrigerator and a cozy lounge. The hunting manager, Maciej, speaks German. There is access to a locked garage and cold storage. Wi-Fi and mobile coverage are available.

Milicz is 240 km from the border crossing at Forst/Olszyna, 16 km from the town of Milicz, and 65 km from Wroc?aw, the nearest international airport.
