Overview

France has a very strong population of red deers and from mid-September many French forests are full of rutting stags, one of nature's most fantastic "shows". At this time of the year, the big stags are coming out of the forest thickets.

Our partner in France has different territories in the Pyrenees, and you can expect a fantastically exciting and challenging hunt in the mountains. The areas are very varied and the variety of the biotope makes these areas the ideal habitat for red deers.

There is everything from dense forests, open areas, beautiful mountain meadows, high plains, a little agriculture and larger grazing areas. The Pyrenees is therefore the place if you want to experience exciting red stag hunting in a unique terrain!

Attractions

Besides hunting, it is also an interesting area of ??France. Here, where the country is "narrowest", there are only approx. 200 km to both the Atlantic and the Mediterranean. There are many interesting old towns and castles, e.g. Toulouse, famous Lourdes as well as Pau, and the tiny country of Andorra are also close by. And not least, the wonderful food and good wines alone are worth a trip. Also for any non-hunting part of the family, this will be a very attractive destination as there are many attractions and plenty of activity opportunities.

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Pyrenean red stag

The red stags in the Pyrenees are very similar to the Spanish red stags, only the price is significantly cheaper. You can expect to shoot stags weighing between 4 - 7 kg in trophy weight, 8 - 12 points and with an age of at least 7 years. The guides are very selective and the red stags are chosen wisely. On these hunts, it's quality over quantity!

Hunting period (20 September - 15 October)

The best period for red stag hunting is from the end of September to mid-October, when the stags are iruttingt. Here there are good opportunities to experience the intense rut, where the stags roar and fight over the obstacles. It is something every hunter should try to experience.

Rental rifle

It is possible to rent a rifle from our French partner. He offers, among other things, Blaser R8 prof. success in caliber 30.06 with a quality binocular from Zeiss. If you want to bring your own rifle, you must be aware that our partner requires you to shoot with a silencer.

Flights

The simplest is to fly to Toulouse, and here you can either rent a car or we can organize transfer to the hunting grounds. We are of course happy to help you book the flight.









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During the hunt, in most cases, our hunters will stay in a small but very charming guesthouse/hotel/pension, either in a small mountain village or out in the countryside. Generally speaking or hunters have been very enthusiastic about the choice of accommodation, which is often a carefully restored building, several centuries old, which has been transformed into a comfortable, tastefully furnished property, with all modern facilities. The food also receives high praise. It is often the owners of the establishment who run the kitchen, conjuring up one delicious dish after another. Your stay here will include full board.

In the Pyrenees there are plenty of exciting atractions to explore either before or after your hunt. Sarlat is a very attractive medical town, while you can visit many beautiful, charming villages, chateaux and large cave systems with underground rock formations and ancient cave paintings.









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Our partner, Julien, is both an outfitter and professional hunter, who has been carefully building up his successful company over a number of years. We have enjoyed an excellent working relationship with Julien since 2012, and he has really taken great care of our hunters, giving them some great hunting experiences and some fine trophies.

Julien offers roebuck hunting during the summer, while during the autumn and winter he concentrates on hunting chamois, mouflon and red deer.

Together with his skilled hunting guides, he takes care of all aspects of your hunt and accommodation here. He makes sure you will stay as close to the hunting district you will hunt in as possible, that all the licenses and paperwork are taken care of, and that your trophies will get the best possible treatment.









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In the Pyreneese we can offer two different red deer districts. The first is close to Font-Romeu which is to the west/south west of Perpignan and the other is near Massat, to the south of Toulouse.

Here you will enjoy challenging hunting in very beautiful, varied, forest-clad terrain. You can come across both dense forest, clearings, beautiful mountain meadows and barren rocky areas. There is little in the way of agriculture, which is mainly only pastoral here.

The trophies are similar in size to those from Spanish Red deer, but prices here are significantly cheaper. You can expect trophies of between 4 and 7 kg, 8-12 pointers with a minimum age of 7 years.

The nearest airport is Toulouse.
