Roebuck Hunting in Poland

Roebuck hunting in Poland has become a wonderful tradition amongst rifle hunters. The season starts in the spring - on May 11th -, and continues right up to the end of September. In other words it is possible to enjoy both hunting earlier in the spring as well as an exciting, traditional rut hunt in July/August, when it is possible to call-up the bucks. If you are a true roebuck enthusiast, you really should not miss any of these highlights!

The population of roe deer in Poland is, thanks to longstanding strict game management policies, both very large and very dense. Year after year this wealth of game brings hunters from all over north western Europe to the vast Polish hunting districts to try their luck.

We can offer a wide range of the very best State Forest Districts in western Poland, all of which can deliver top quality roebuck hunts. The Polish districts can offer trophies of different sizes, leaving you free to choose whether you would prefer to hunt for a number of smaller bucks or go for a single, really good, trophy. These State Forest Districts all have well trained, experienced and very responsible hunting guides, who each have their own areas in the districts, which they know like the back of their own hands.

The hunt usually takes the form of stalking or lying in wait on one of the towers that have been optimally placed in each district, with regard to the deer's behavioural patterns. You will go out hunting twice a day, once in the early morning starting before dawn, and again in the late afternoon/evening during the hours around sunset.

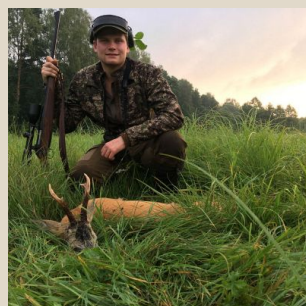

PARTNER RDLP Toruń



We have worked together with the Regional Direction of State Forests in Toruń – the Regionalna Dyrekcja Lasów Państwowych we Toruniu, or in everyday language the RDLP Toruń – for the last 21 years, and before that Wilson Jagtrejser (which later became Diana) worked together with some of the districts. Our partnership includes 8 state forest districts, and we have long term agreements with all 8 districts. Of the rest (= 19) of RDLP Toruń's total of 27 districts, the hunting is let out to various Polish hunting associations. Some of the districts lie in the "Bory Tucholski" – Poland's biggest forest complex.

In common for all the state-owned districts under RDLP Toruń, which was established in 1925 and is one of the oldest regional directions, is good, professional and stable game management, with each district having its own speciality. Some of them stand out because of their fantastic stag hunts, others because of their well organized driven hunts - while some districts can simply do it all. More information given under the individual districts and we will of course be happy to provide more detailed information via telephone or email.

When hunting in a state-owned district accommodation is normally provided in the hunting district itself – and not in a hotel in town. In this way our customers can enjoy a "total experience". The game is usually taken back to your accommodation so your hunting companions can join the celebrations. In some districts you can lie in bed at night and listen to the red deer stags roar during the September rut.

A hunt on one of the districts under RDLP Toruń is clearly a good choice!

HUNTING AREA Wierzchlas



Our Wierzchlas hunting district covers a total area of 11,773 hectares, of which 7,068 hectares are forest, while the remaining 4,705 hectares consist of agricultural land, meadows, and wetlands. The forest is primarily coniferous, with scattered oak and birch. The area is mostly flat, with some gently undulating terrain, numerous larger and smaller lakes, and water holes. Wierzchlas has more than 100 high seats, as well as 30 feeding places. Up to 5 hunters can hunt at a time for roe deer bucks and red deer stags on individual hunts, while popular combined hunts can be arranged for 6-8 hunters.

The district has excellent populations of red deer, but it also offers good roe buck hunting. Additionally, there are wild boar and a small population of fallow deer. Every year, around 30 roe deer bucks are shot. Trophy-wise, most of the bucks weigh under 300 grams net, but some bucks are harvested weighing over 300 grams, with some even over 350 grams. The annual red deer quota is 28 stags, most of which have a trophy weight of 4.5-6.5 kg. However, stags weighing over 7 kg are also shot each year.

Currently, no fallow deer are released for hunting. Wild boars are

still present at Wierzchlas, and they are hunted both on individual hunts throughout the season and on driven hunts/combined hunts during the autumn and winter months. The driven hunts are typically arranged for groups of 6-8 hunters, combined with individual hunting.

The combined hunt works as follows: at around 8:00 am, after a hearty breakfast, the day begins with driven hunts featuring small drives of varying durations. Around 12-1 pm, the driven hunt concludes, and hunters return to the accommodation for a break and lunch. Each hunter is then assigned a hunting guide for the rest of the afternoon and evening, which is spent on individual hunting. If the weather permits, wild boar hunting may continue into the evening – note that it is legal to use night vision for wild boar hunting. The parade will typically consist of a mix of red deer, wild boar, roe deer, and foxes, and the district expects shots to be taken at the game that comes forward to achieve a satisfactory result (though not necessarily stags).
