Mauritius also offers hunting for world class rusa stags. We have access to the best district, where the stags are huge and where only stags of gold medal winning class are shot. An unusual trophy for your collection - and one of an impressive size to boot. The same outfitter can also arrange hunting for the island's variety of wild boar -"brown pigs".

During your visit you will stay in the 5-star Hotel Heritage Awali, a really nice hotel, that lies right next to a wonderful beach on the southern part of the island. The hotel offers a wide range of facets and activities. These include 6 swimming pools, 11 restaurants, 2 spas and wellness centres, an activity center, and a magnificent 18 hole golf course with the green fees included in the price of the hotel. Accommodation at Awali is on an all inclusive basis, that is to say 3 meals a day, all drinks, as well as various snacks. Up to 2 children under 12 years of age can stay free of charge if they shear their parents room.

For the same price it is also possible to stay in the nearby 5-star hotel Le Telfair with half board. You get picked up at the hotel and driven to the hunting area by the hunting guide. In Mauritius, it is ideal to bring non-hunting participants, as there are many activities if you do not want to go hunting, such as scuba diving, sunbathing, golf, spa and massage, and of course, big game fishing. We would also recommend that you spend a day or two on sight-seeing on the beautiful island. Upon arrival in Mauritius will be picked up by our partner at the airport and also brought back afterwards.









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Partner in Mauritius

Our partner on Mauritius offers the best hunting for Rusa deer on the island. The outfitter we use has, without doubt, the best hunting districts and offers very well organized hunting. The population of game here is very impressive, consisting of very large Rusa deer. He can therefore guarantee that you will shoot a gold medal Rusa stag.

We have not only had great success sending hunters to Mauritius, which we have done since 2010, but hunter's families who do not themselves hunt, have been very happy with our concept: hunting takes place over 1-2 days, while the rest of the holiday is spent sharing "quality time" with the whole family, relaxing in beautiful surroundings, enjoying the wide range of activities available, and spoiling oneself in a hotel of a very high standard.

Our partner has been offering hunting on Mauritius since 2003, and today they are without doubt the leading hunting outfitters on the island.

The hunting is always carried out with 1:1 guiding and all of the guides speak excellent English, often with a charming French

accent.

If you would like guided tours around the island, this can certainly be arranged, and our partners are also very happy to help arrange big game fishing.

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HUNTING AREA Bell Ombre

The hunt takes place in an inland district on the southern part of the island. The 3,800ha district is quite hilly, and the vegetation here consists of forest, open fields and dense bush. From many places in the district you can enjoy wonderful views over the Indian Ocean. In addition to Bell Ombre, the hunt manager also has access to a number of other districts on the island. The hunt takes the form of stalking, and even though the district is surrounded by fences, and has a fantastic population of deer, it is certainly not always easy to stalk in to your selected stag.

As Rusa stags are largely inactive in the early morning, the hunt normally starts during the middle of the day and hunting then continues to sunset.

The Rusa deer, (Cervus timorensis rusa) was introduced to Mauritius from Java by a Dutch governor in 1639.Since then it has really thrived here and has spread over large parts of the island. A fully grown stag can weigh between 140-160 kg. The stags drop their antlers in mid-December, and their new set will finish growing in May. Their rut takes place from mid-July to the end of August, however this species is unusual as another rut takes place in October. But no matter when the hunt takes place in the period from June to December, the success rate is 100%. Because of the excellent population of deer here, the price of our hunting packages include a gold medal stag (Rowland Ward) of up to 34 inches. If you would like a stag of over 34 inches, then you must state inform us at the time of booking. It is also possible to hunt wild boar or "brown pig" as this species is called on Mauritius. Although these boars do not achieve anywhere near the size of an European wild boar, a good keiler here will weigh 50-70 kg, they can still produce some rather impressive tusks. Furthermore we can also offer wing shooting for pheasants and partriges, either as beats or with dogs. The hunting guides all speak English, they are very good hunters, and are very service minded. In general the local population on Mauritius are extremely friendly.
