

Overview

Black Bear Hunting in the Monashee Mountains – Adams Lake, British Columbia

Adams Lake is located in southern British Columbia, surrounded by the impressive Monashee Mountains. The area is renowned for its strong game populations, professional wildlife management, and high ethical hunting standards. The outfitter operating here is recognized for excellent service, proven success rates, and a well-organized, streamlined hunting operation.

The territory holds healthy populations of black bear, grizzly bear, cougar, mountain goat, mule deer, whitetail deer, and moose. Both elk and mountain caribou are also present in the area; however, hunting licenses for these species are currently not issued.

The Hunt

Spring black bear hunting in British Columbia offers more than just the hunt itself – it is a complete wilderness experience in the heart of Canada's rugged outdoors. As winter loosens its grip, the landscape bursts to life with green shoots, blooming flowers, and lush vegetation – and it is precisely in these areas that the bears emerge to feed, making them easier to locate.

Hunting is conducted by a combination of four-wheel-drive vehicles, ATVs, and in some areas, by boat to efficiently cover the vast terrain. Once a huntable bear is spotted, the hunt continues on foot with a carefully executed stalk to get within safe shooting range.

The terrain offers diverse hunting conditions, including mountainous regions, forested areas, and open meadows where game can often be observed from a distance. In addition to bears, moose, whitetail deer, and mule deer are commonly seen throughout the area, adding to the variety and excitement of the hunt.

The outfitter customizes each hunt to the individual client and ensures that every hunter is accompanied by an experienced guide with in-depth knowledge of the wildlife behavior and terrain.

This destination is ideal for hunters seeking a professionally organized hunt in exclusive surroundings, with an emphasis on authentic outdoor experiences and sustainable wildlife management.

High Success Rates and Traditional Spot-and-Stalk Bear Hunting

The Adams Lake area is known for its strong game populations and high success rates for both black bear and grizzly bear hunts. Please note, however, that grizzly bear trophies from British Columbia cannot be imported into the EU.

Adams Lake boasts a dense bear population, and hunting here differs significantly from stationary baited hunts. This is true, fair chase spot-and-stalk hunting in the wilderness. Together with your guide, you actively explore the terrain on foot, by boat, or by vehicle, searching for game in its natural habitat.

During a typical six-day hunt, it is not unusual to encounter 20 to 30 different bears, and there is also an excellent chance of harvesting the highly sought-after color phase (brown) black bear. That said, hunting success depends heavily on weather conditions, which is why we recommend planning your hunt for the second half of May, when spring is fully underway and bear activity peaks.



The main camp lies on the western side of the Shuswap Mountains, but there is often used smaller satellite camps during the hunt. These smaller camps can be so-called "wall-tents" or a camping trailer.

Our hunters fly to Vancouver or Calgary and on with a domestic fligt to Kelowna, where you will get picked up and transportet to the camp.

There are boats and canoes in the camp, so if you want to, you can fish for Dolly Varden, rainbow trout, salmon and pike.

Sometimes you also hunt from the boat, particularly for moose and black bear.





Adams Lake Outfitter's hunting district lies in British Columbia. To be more precise it lies between Shuswap Lake and Adams Lake, north east of the town of Kamploops. The hunting district itself covers around 178.000 ha. And consists of a beautiful, varied landscape with mountains, lakes, large areas of wetlands and meadows. From the town of Kelowna, where our hunters will be met by the outfitter, it is around an hours drive to the hunting district.

There are many forest clearings in the district, in which much fresh, lush vegetation is able to grow. In turn this good food source attracts many different species of animal to the district.

There are good populations of black bear, grizzly (Mountain Silvertip), puma, mountain goat, mule deer and whitetail deer, together with moose. Furthermore wapiti and mountain caribou are also present in this district, but up to now no licences have been issued for these two game species.

The climate is very mild during the spring and autumn, hot during the summer, while during the winter this district sees massive falls of snow.

The accommodation in which our hunters stay during the hunt depends on exactly where the hunt takes place, and on which species is being hunter. You might stay in "wall tents", cabins or campingtrailers, it is even possible to stay in a hotel under some circumstances.

During the hunt you might use different modes of transport, such as 4wd vehicles, ATV's or snow scooters. Once a promising game animal has been spotted, you will stalk your game on foot until you are close enough to safely take your shot.
