

Wild boars in Turkey are significantly larger, both in body and trophy size, than European wild boar. Keilers can weigh more than 300kg, and their tusks can reach lengths of around 30cm! The Turks, due to their religious convictions, do not hunt wild boar. Neither do they keep domestic pigs, which would have the potential of polluting the vigorous race of wild boar with poor genes.







Spot-and-Stalk Hunt



Overview

The low hunting pressure results in a dense population or boar and opens up the possibility of hunting for big individuals that have not become accustomed to being hunted.

Our partner has access to a wide range of first class wild boar districts, with a total area of around one million hectares. The most important districts are found in Anatolia and along the south coast of the Black Sea. The districts consist of hilly, highland forest - typically lying between 1,000 -1,500m above sea level. It is possible to carry out the hunt both as a stalk or as lying in wait, depending on the preferences and fitness of the hunter.

Our partner's staff invests a lot of time in observing the boars and they all know when the boars will be active in their districts. It is not unusual to shoot a number of large keiler during a visit here.

The hunt normally only takes place in the evening and at night, as the keilers are in-active during the day and therefore hardly ever seen.

Every day the hunting guide will pick you up at the hotel and take you to the hunting area, and as the different feeding places can be relatively far apart, you drive from place to place and then stalk to the feeding places.

We warmly recommend good scopes and possibly a night scope.

If you want a single room, or if you are traveling alone, you will be charged for single room.









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


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Our partner in Turkey, Gönye Hunting Activities is one of the very biggest and most important players in the Turkish hunting market. They have their headquarters in the city of Konya in central Turkey, and in 2017 will be celebrating their 20 year jubilee. Over this period they have built up a large, professional organization with good hunting guides, interpreters, drivers etc. We have been working with Gönye since 2008. Generally their hunting guides are very experienced and have a thorough knowledge of the districts they are hunting in. Some of them speak a little English or German, but you should not expect too much of your guide when it comes to language skills.

When it comes to hunting for Anatolian wild boar Gönye can offer hunting over an impressive total of circa 3 million hectares in 15 different regions of Turkey, where they can arrange both individual hunts and driven hunts. They can also offer a further 11 different districts in the Taurus Mountains where you can hunt for the very attractive bezoar ibex. On top of this they can offer hunting for the rare Konya sheep, Anatolian roebuck and red stag, Anatolian gazelle and Anatolian chamois. When hunting in Turkey guiding is more or less always 1:1, with the exception of driven

hunts.

Generally it has to be said that when you hunt in Turkey you will be met by great friendliness and hospitality from your Turkish hosts, but it is also important that you are prepared to meet a very different culture and altitude to life than you might be used to.







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HUNTING AREA Hunting Area - Hunt for Wild Boar in Turkey

Our partner in Turkey has top wild boar hunting areas in various regions of Turkey. Everywhere there is a strong population of wild boar with many kapitale boars from. The Turks themselves driver hunting of wild boars significantly as hunting pressure is low.

The Turkish wild boars can reach a body weight of over 300 kg and trophies of between 20 and 35 cm. In the last three years the average length of the teeth been at 21 to 23 cm, with each class of 25-31 cm.

Our partner has a number of large hunting areas in the country. The primary hunting areas for wild boars is located in Anatolia around the city of Konya and in the Black Sea region, 2 - 3 ½-hour drive from Ankara. All in all, does he occupy about 1 million hectares of hunting areas. Most hunting areas is relatively hilly, with forested mountains mainly with pine, spruce and oak, and scrub with, among other juniper. Also in Turkey, the hunting conditions change with regard to weather or fourageringsmulighder., So therefore our hunters senndt to the areas where you expect the best hunting results, and sometimes

there will also be a matter of changing from a revir to another -

even shortly before departure, but this is done only to ensure the best possible hunting.

The hunt takes place usually only in the evenings and at night when keilerne day is inactive, and therefore hardly be seen. The hunt itself is a combination of pürsch- and decorum hunting by feeding places and ponds. Hunters are daily downloaded by hunting drivers in the accommodation and driven out of the district, and when the districts are so vast and large, run it from place to place, then stalking into the feeding places.

We heartily recommend that you provide good and bright optics and possible. night vision goggles. Our partner provides weapons declaration at the airport, transfer, driving during the hunt, accommodation at a local hotel or pension
