Winter Hunt for Musk Ox



Overview

Greenland is like a fairytale come true for the nature lover and hunter in us all. The magnificent nature is overwhelming. Something you will remember the rest of your life. Greenland offers pristine hunting districts, fresh air, there are no electricity pylons on the horizon, and the only sounds you hear are nature's own. At night the stars are clearer than you have ever seen before, unless they are eclipsed by the endlessly beautiful Northern Lights, which if you are lucky, can be seen at these latitudes in their full glory. The hunt for musk ox is really exciting. This animal must be treated with respect, it can attack if it feels threatened. Hunters will be in the company of guides who have years experience of hunting musk ox, the districts and conditions in Greenland. There will always be somebody there who can speak English. It is possible to hunt for arctic fox, arctic hare and ptarmigan at no extra cost.

THE HUNT

The hunt for musk ox is carried out on an eight wheeled (Argo 8) or ATV vehicle. These have proven to be more effective than using dog sleds. These vehicles are used to spot the game, once this is done the hunt begins. The stalk can take over a distance of 200 - 1500m.

Hunters will be met in Sdr. Stromfjord and driven 1 to 1.5 hrs to camp by snow scooter or similar. Hunters should have an average level of fitness. The hunting party will return to camp each evening. After the hunt our customers will be taken back to Sdr. Strøm by snow-scooter.

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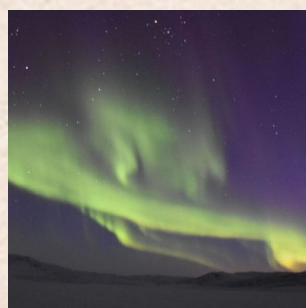
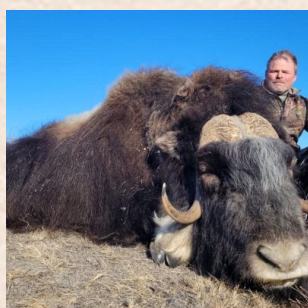
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If the weather is favourable, it is possible to arrange a dog sled tour after the hunt.

THE MUSK OX (*Ovibos moschatus*)

The musk ox has just been included in the European Grand. The musk ox is a tundra dweller, and is more closely related to sheep and goats than cattle. The musk ox was originally found along the east coast of Greenland, but was prevented from "colonising" the whole of Greenland by its fjords, glaciers and fells. At the start of the 60's 27 musk ox were released near Kangerlussuaq - a hunting district with no borders covering 6,600 km².

The population has grown over the last 40 years or so, and the population is estimated to be at least 7000 animals. The vegetation and feeding in the district is so good here that the musk ox grows 15% larger than in other parts of Greenland, fully grown bulls reaching 375 kg.



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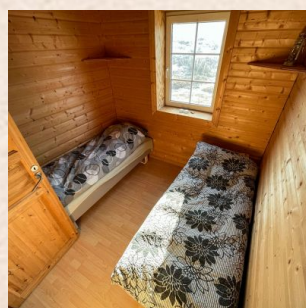
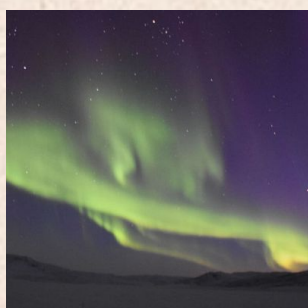
ACCOMMODATION Inuit Outfitting - Greenland



The hunting district is in a really beautiful spot in the wilds of Greenland, and the camp lies close to 2 large lakes. It is possible to freely hunt small game (depending on local hunting season* / shotguns can sometimes be borrowed in the camp) and fish for arctic char.

The camp consists of huts and has space for 4 hunters, poss. 5 if you know each other and are travelling together. There will also be 2 hunting guides and an interpreter in camp. The sanitary arrangements in camp are very primitive.

The hunting district is in a beautiful location by a large lake close to the Inland-ice, around 35km from Kangerlussuaq in West Greenland.

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HUNTING AREA

Hunting Area - Winter hunting on musk oxen



The hunting district is in a beautiful location by a large lake close to the Inland-ice, around 35km from Kangerlussuaq in West Greenland.

Søndre Strømfjord or as it is called in Greenlandic - Kangerlussuaq - is transected by the Arctic circle, which means in summer it never really gets dark, while in mid-winter there is nearly no light apart from moonlight and the fantastic northern lights. During March, when the hunt takes place, there is more than 12 hours daylight per day, as the day quickly get longer at these latitudes.

Normally you set off from camp in groups to search for the musk oxen. It is agreed in advance with the individual hunters whether the last stage of the hunt will be carried out 1:1, or whether one or more others may follow the hunt from a distance. The hunters wishes will again be taken into consideration before the final stalk is started.

In the winter there is a good chance of also hunting for snow hares, ptarmigan and arctic fox. Hunters must be very well

dressed during the hunt. Comfortable sealskin clothes can be hired on payment of a supplement. This should be arranged when booking the tour.
